### Lake Eyre

Depart Parachilna flying north with views of the Flinders Ranges to your right. Follow Lake Torrens to the Marree Man en route to Lake Eyre North. Explore Jackboot Bay & overfly Dalhenty Island in search of the spectacular birdlife before returning via the Madigan Gulf, landing at Muloorina Station where you can stretch your legs and view a flowing artesian bore. Depart Muloorina returning to Parachilna via Marree and the Leigh Creek Coalfields with views of Wilpena Pound & the majestic Flinders Ranges in the distance.

### Lake Eyre and Head Waters of The Cooper Creek

Depart Parachilna flying north with Lake Torrens to your left and past Leigh Creek to the right. Fly over the Oodnadatta Track past Marree to your right. Land at Muloorina Station where you can stretch your legs and view a flowing artesian bore. Depart Muloorina Station flying over the Madigan Gulf in Lake Eyre North where Sir Edward Campbell set a world speed record in 1964. Fly to the mouth of Jackboot Bay where you will have views of endless water and some birdlife. Then turn east and fly towards Cooper Creek and along it to the head of the flood waters. See the ferry that crosses the Cooper Creek at Etadunna before following the Birdsville Track south en route to Parachilna via Leigh Creek Coal Fields and Aroona Dam.

### Lake Eyre and William Creek

Depart Parachilna flying north with views of the Flinders Ranges to your right. Fly past Mt Deception and over Marree, at the junction of the Birdsville and Oodnadatta Tracks. Cross the Dog Fence before landing at Muloorina Station where you can stretch your legs and view a flowing artesian bore while we refuel.

Depart Muloorina flying over the Goyder Channel and the Madigan Gulf via the mouth of Jackboot Bay en route to Dalhenty Island. Fly over Belt Bay and then leave Lake Eyre North for William Creek. Arrive at William Creek where you can have a break and some lunch.

Depart William Creek flying along the Oodnadatta Track past Lake Eyre South and Marree. Return to Parachilna flying along the North Eastern shores of Lake Torrens.

## **Lake Eyre, Birdsville and the Headwaters of Cooper Creek**

### **Day 1**

Depart Parachilna for Muloorina Station for Muloorina Station where you can view a flowing artesian bore while we refuel, before we depart for Lake Eyre & The Warburton Groove. Follow the Warburton with the Simpson Desert on the left & the Tirari Desert on the right, to Cowarie Station. Stop for a quick stretch of the legs before heading on to Birdsville, flying over Goyder's Lagoon & the Diamantina with the Georgina River flowing in from the north. Check-in at the iconic Birdsville Hotel and if time permits a tour of the Birdsville Museum.

### **Day 2**

Depart Birdsville flying south along the famous Birdsville Track past Pandi Pandi and Clifton Hills Stations. Fly past Mungerannie and Mulka to the headwaters of the Cooper Creek on Etadunna Station then back to Muloorina for a fuel stop before returning to The Prairie Hotel. Arrive in the early afternoon passing over the Strzelecki Track & the Leigh Creek Coal Fields on the way.

## **Lake Eyre, Birdsville and Innamincka**

### **Day 1**

Depart Parachilna for Muloorina Station where you can view a flowing artesian bore while we refuel, before departing for Lake Eyre & The Warburton Groove. Follow the Warburton with the Simpson Desert on the left & the Tirari Desert on the right to Cowarie Station. Stop for a quick stretch of the legs before heading on to Birdsville flying over Goyder's Lagoon & the Diamantina with The Georgina River flowing in from the north. Check-in at the iconic Birdsville Hotel and if time permits a tour of the Birdsville Museum.

### **Day 2**

Depart Birdsville to the south east, flying over the Strzelecki Desert and Coongie Lakes. Cross the South Australian / Queensland Border and land at the famous Dig Tree. Fly a short leg back across the border stopping at Innamincka.

Depart Innamincka flying along the Strzelecki Track past Lake Blanche to Arkaroola. Fly over the Flinders Ranges and the Gammon Ranges before arriving back at Parachilna.
